Temporary Lane Closures on DC-295

October 6 – October 13

ANACOSTIA FREEWAY BRIDGES OVER NICHOLSON STREET PROJECT

(Washington, DC) – The District Department of Transportation (DDOT) will temporarily close lanes of traffic on DC-295 beginning Sunday, October 6 through Sunday, October 13 to perform resurfacing work, weather permitting.

From Sunday, October 6 through Friday, October 11 DC-295 northbound and southbound will alternate temporary lane closures from 8 p.m. to 5 a.m. to perform the work.

Two lanes of DC-295 northbound from the 11th Street SE Bridge to Pennsylvania Avenue SE will be closed from 8 p.m. to 5 a.m. One lane of traffic will be open to motorists during the work.

Two lanes of DC-295 southbound from Pennsylvania Avenue SE to the 11th Street SE Bridge will be closed from 8 p.m. to 5 a.m. One lane of traffic will be open to motorists during the work.

A lane of traffic on DC-295 northbound will temporarily close on Friday, October 11 and Saturday, October 12 from 8 p.m. to 5 a.m. The right lane of DC-295 southbound will be closed Saturday, October 12 from 8 a.m. to 8 p.m.

Traffic controls will be in place to warn drivers approaching the areas and guide them through the construction zone. Drivers are advised to take an alternate route or alternate travel times to avoid delays, stay alert while traveling through these locations and to be observant of the work zone.
